Kevin has secured a location for a pop-up store for Christmas shopping. Initial schedule would be first 2 weeks of December. Kevin will have more details at the September meeting. We have had a few instances of course or cart damage. Most incidents seem to happen later in the day. We may need to consider a ranger more often and for longer periods of time. Mixed night has been a success. We are seeing people that don't normally golf, and hopefully that will translate into more players in 2024. Our match play event through September has sold out. 32 players will do a couple more in 2024. Both men and women have said they enjoyed the event.

Alyssa explained how the first Mixed Night went with 21 Green Fees, 54 Golfers (27 teams). It was discussed that moving forward Wednesday night's will be mixed night with tee times and a Shot Gun Start at 5:15pm was set for August 30, 2023.
